Can outsiders successfully contribute?




August 2015

More inventive government


1. Tell the public experiments are for learning.

2. Stage budgets.
Stop what's not working. Scale what is.

3. Experiment with the public. Not on them.

4. Remind people when the *status quo* is the less safe choice.

5. Build "portfolios" of experiments.
