OUR SERVICE POPULATION

In October of 2017, Navy Safe Harbor reported 3,352 WII, CAT2/3 annual patients. **59% of those are receiving treatment for cancer or mental illness** and 41% are receiving treatment for injuries. 22% of those receiving care are combat related. Unfortunately, other service branches will not release their numbers.
