#### OVERVIEW

Idaho's Ada County Highway District (ACHD) oversees more than 5,000 miles of roadways and bridges, with a focus on public safety and engaging the community. ACHD partnered with Granicus and implemented digital tools to successfully launch its engagement site, ACHD Engage, to streamline and improve how they connect with Idaho drivers.

#### SITUATION | Disjointed processes in need of modernization

ACHD engages the community to provide input, while improving safety and providing proper maintenance of roads, sidewalks, and related infrastructure. ACHD operations were disjointed, and they were using separate online survey tools that were not integrated with the website. The agency improved engagement and streamlined its processes by implementing govDelivery, EngagementHQ, and govAccess website solutions.

The agency wanted to eliminate unnecessary work and create more efficient processes.
